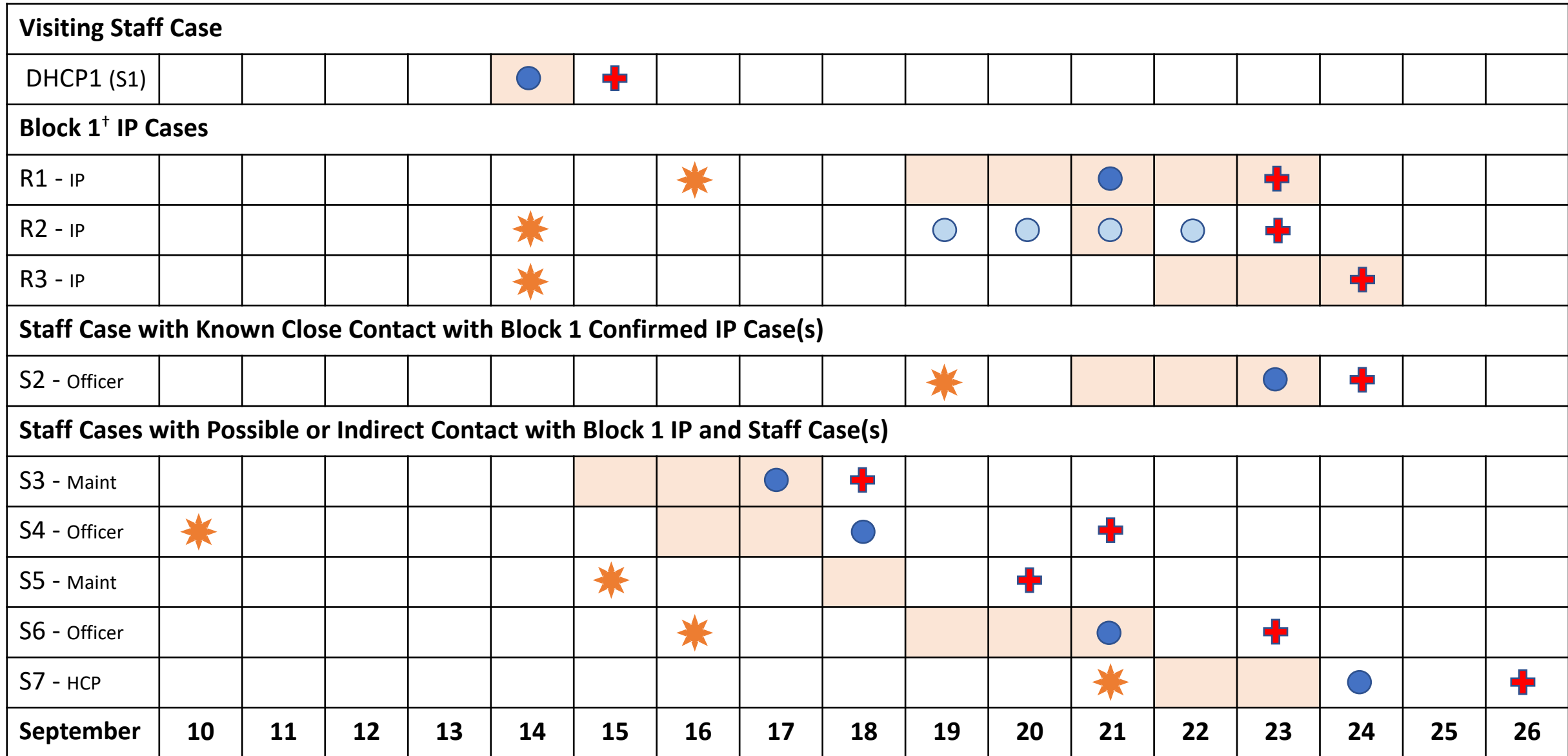






* Estimated as date 48 hours prior to symptom onset (i.e., potential infectious period) in the patient to whom the case was exposed or treated 48 hours after the case to whom they were exposed was initially exposed (i.e., minimum estimated incubation period)

† Estimated as range between: (a) the date 48 hours prior to symptom onset in the case OR 48 hours before testing positive by RT-PCR if asymptomatic or symptom onset date is unknown, and (b) the latest date on which the case could have exposed others at the facility (i.e., last date worked for staff and date of isolation for IP).
