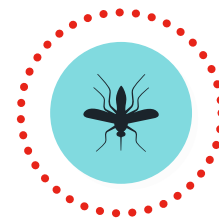

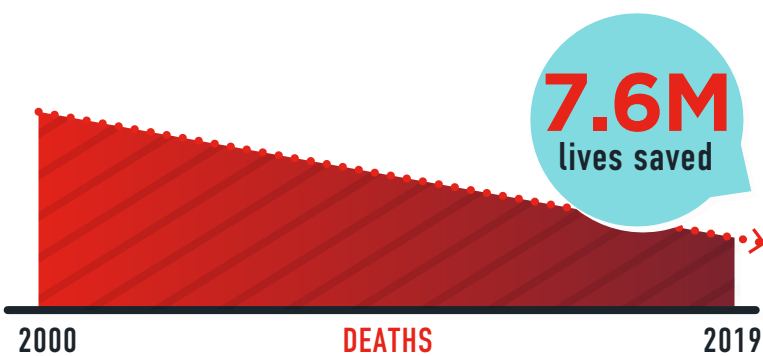

Treatments for malaria and bed nets provided by global partners

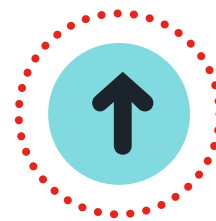
CDC'S IMPACT
