<p>Balance of consequences</p>	<p>Undesirable consequences <i>clearly outweigh</i> desirable consequences in most settings</p>	<p>Undesirable consequences <i>probably outweigh</i> desirable consequences in most settings</p>	<p>The balance between desirable and undesirable consequences <i>is closely balanced or uncertain</i></p>	<p>Desirable consequences <i>probably outweigh</i> undesirable consequences in most settings</p>	<p>Desirable consequences <i>clearly outweigh</i> undesirable consequences in most settings</p>	<p>There is insufficient evidence to determine the balance of consequences</p>
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<p>Type of recommendation</p>	<p>We do not recommend the intervention</p>	<p>We recommend the intervention for individuals based on shared clinical decision-making</p>	<p>We recommend the intervention</p>
