
In the figures below, the dark red bars/dark blue bars represent the percentage of all vaccinated people who fall into each demographic group, and the gray bars represent the percentage of all people in the U.S. population who fall into each demographic group. If all groups got vaccinated according to their share of the population, the dark red/dark blue bars would be the same length as the gray bars.

 Instances where the red bar is shorter than the gray bar indicate that the number of people in that group who received at least one shot is




