**1 in 3** American Indian/Alaska Native adults are caregivers

CAREGIVERS provide regular care or assistance to a FRIEND or FAMILY member with a health problem or disability

### **CAREGIVING CAN BE**

LENGTHY Over Half have provided care for at least two years

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INTENSE Nearly half have provided care for at least 20 hours per week



## WHO ARE CAREGIVERS?

60% are women

**16%** are 65 years old or older

**32%** are caring for a parent or parent-in-law



### HOW DO CAREGIVERS HELP?



**Over 80%** manage household tasks

**Over 50%** assist with personal care
