American Indian/Alaska Native adults aged 45 years and older are experiencing **S**ubjective **C**ognitive **D**ecline

**SCD** is self-reported MEMORY PROBLEMS that have been GETTING WORSE over the past year.

**57%** of people with SCD had to give up day-to-day activities



## one in two

of people with SCD say it interfered with social activities, work or volunteering





**87%** of people with SCD have at least one chronic condition



discussed their symptoms with a healthcare provider

**51%** of people with SCD need help with household tasks







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
