Guide for obtaining de-identified information from electronic medical records; relevant ICD-10 codes

We recommend you use all the ICD-10 codes listed under a specific diagnosis using “OR” logic to ensure capturing of all relevant diagnoses. Please ensure you filter only for hospitalized patients ages 0-18 years.

Brain abscess, subdural empyema and epidural abscess

Intracranial abscess and granuloma: G060

Intraspinal abscess and granuloma: G061

Orbital cellulitis

Orbital cellulitis, left: H05012

Orbital cellulitis, right: H05011

Orbital cellulitis, bilateral: H05013

Orbital cellulitis, unspecified: H05019

Sinusitis

Chronic sinusitis, unspecified: J329

Other acute sinusitis: J0180

Acute ethmoidal sinusitis, unspecified: J0120

Acute frontal sinusitis, unspecified: J0110

Acute maxillary sinusitis, unspecified: J0100

Acute pansinusitis, unspecified: J0140

Acute sphenoidal sinusitis, unspecified: J0130

Other chronic sinusitis: J328

Sinusitis plus an intracranial abscess

Use all the above ICD-10 codes for sinusitis with “AND” logic for the ICD-10 codes for brain abscess, subdural empyema and epidural abscess

Mastoiditis plus an intracranial abscess

Use all the above ICD-10 codes for mastoiditis with “AND” logic for the ICD-10 codes for brain abscess, subdural empyema and epidural abscess

Acute mastoiditis with other complications, left: H70092

Acute mastoiditis with other complications, right: H70091

Acute mastoiditis with other complications, bilateral: H70093

Acute mastoiditis with other complications, unspecified: H70099

Subperiosteal abscess of the mastoid, left: H70012

Subperiosteal abscess of the mastoid, right: H70011

Subperiosteal abscess of the mastoid, bilateral: H70013

Subperiosteal abscess of the mastoid, unspecified: H70019

Acute mastoiditis without complications, left: H70002

Acute mastoiditis without complications, right: H70001

Acute mastoiditis without complications, bilateral: H70003
