

Hospitalizations and inhospital deaths primarily for COVID-19 had a primary discharge diagnosis of COVID-19 or a secondary discharge diagnosis of COVID-19 accompanied by either treatment with remdesivir or a primary diagnosis of sepsis, pulmonary embolism, acute respiratory failure, or pneumonia.
