




### The P4VE program aims to increase vaccine equity\* in racial and ethnic minority communities by providing:

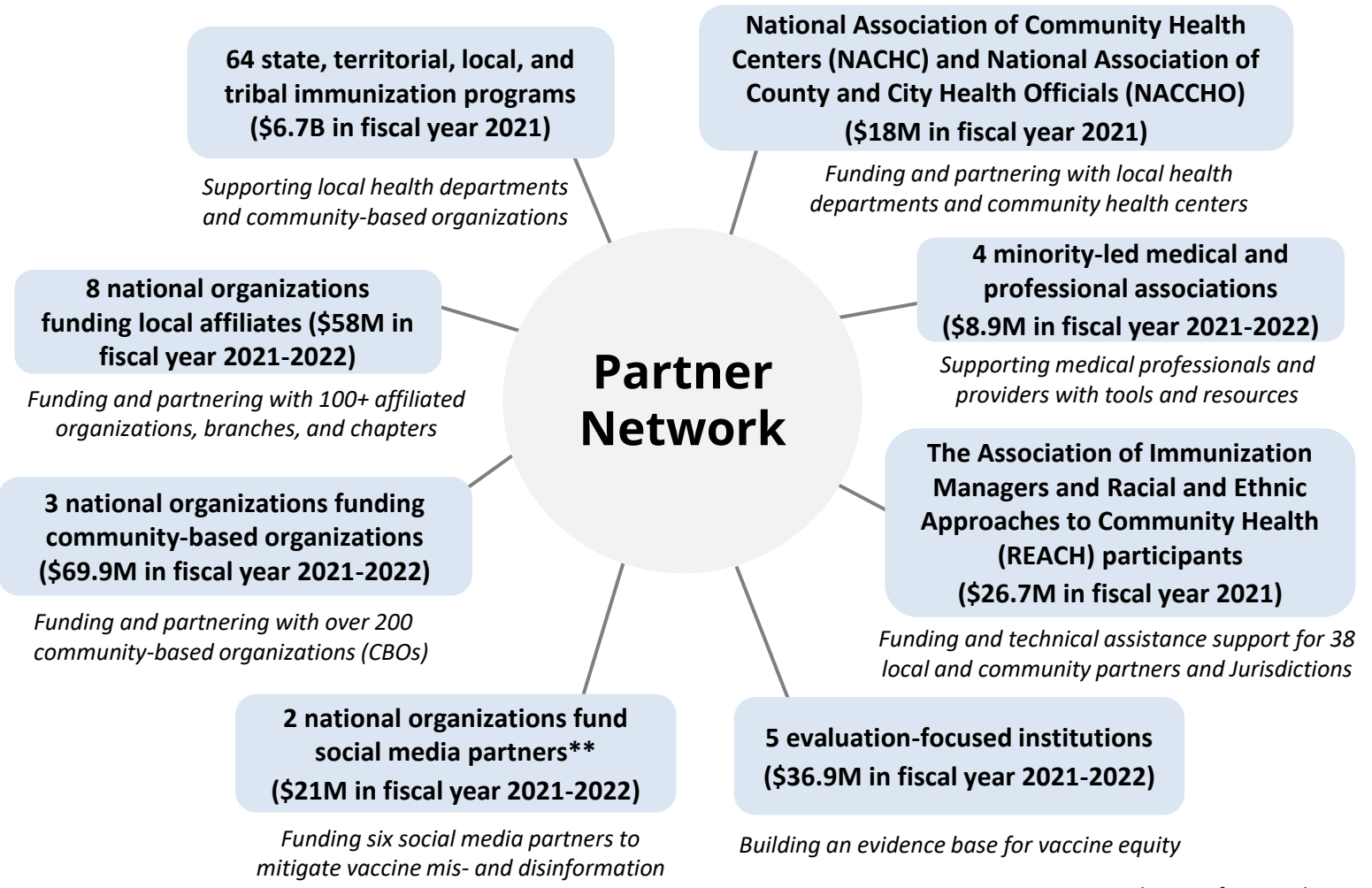
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**Support for national, state, local and community-based organizations** that implement activities focused on vaccine awareness, access, availability, and confidence in disproportionately affected adult populations.
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**A learning community, resource repository, and data technical assistance** that support partners with webinars, tailored resources, coaching, peer-to-peer information-sharing, and more.
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**National communications** disseminating vaccine information, addressing mis- and dis-information, and building vaccine confidence.
