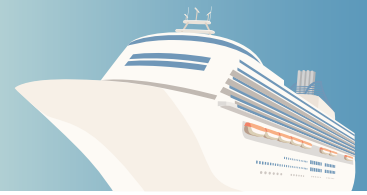


# Submitting Acute Gastroenteritis (AGE) Reports



Use this chart to help ensure your ship complies with **Vessel Sanitation Program (VSP)** reporting requirements. Thank you!

▶ **Remember:** Case counts are cumulative. Reportable cases should stay on the AGE log, even if the affected person recovered.

## If ship is traveling to the U.S. from a foreign port ...

When 36-24 hours from U.S. port, submit a 24-hour report.



Cases went up but still below 2%?  
When 4 or more hours from U.S. port, submit a 4-hour update report.

*If less than 4 hours away, no additional reports needed.*



If cases reach **2%** and again if they reach **3%** ...

When the ship is sailing between U.S. ports ...

OR ship is within 15 days of arriving at a U.S. port ...
