COVID-NET - Hospitalizaciones por COVID-19 confirmado en laboratorio

COVID-NET es un sistema de vigilancia de la población que recopila datos sobre hospitalizaciones asociadas al COVID-19 confirmado en laboratorio en niños y adultos. La red actual consta de más de 300 hospitales de cuidados intensivos en 13 estados. Las tasas de hospitalizaciones se actualizarán semanalmente. COVID-NET también brinda información clínica importante sobre las hospitalizaciones asociadas al COVID-19, que incluye grupo de edad, sexo, raza/etnia y afecciones subyacentes y otras condiciones.

The [Coronavirus Disease 2019 \(COVID-19\)-Associated Hospitalization Surveillance Network \(COVID-NET\)](#) conducts active, population-based surveillance for laboratory-confirmed COVID-19-associated hospitalizations in children younger than 18 years of age and adults. The network currently includes 98 counties in 13 states that participate in the [Emerging Infections Program](#) (California, Colorado, Connecticut, Georgia, Maryland, Minnesota, New Mexico, New York, Oregon, and Tennessee) or the [Influenza Hospitalization Surveillance Program](#) (Michigan, Ohio, and Utah). COVID-NET covers approximately 10% of the U.S. population, or around 32 million people.

The rates presented on the COVID-NET interactive dashboard can be used to follow trends and comparisons of COVID-19-associated hospitalizations in different demographic groups and over time.

COVID-NET hospitalization data are preliminary and subject to change as more data become available. All data are subject to reporting lags that might increase around holidays or during periods of increased hospital utilization. As new data are received each week, previous case counts and rates are updated accordingly.
