DOING MORE

Drive Laboratory Quality, Access, Innovation

- Rapid Test Quality Improvement RTQII; Diagnostic Access Initiative; Viral Load Scale-up; Incidence Assays

Accelerate HIV Treatment & "90/90/90"

- Test & Start Roll-out, Differentiated Care, Retention, VL Use

Accelerate Children's HIV Treatment (ACT)

- Double the number of children receiving ART across 10 hardest hit countries between 2014-2016

Prevent Mother-to-Child Transmission

- Option B+ Expansion, Retention, Optimized VL Monitoring

DREAMS Partnership for Adolescent Girls

- Improve and Save Lives in 10 hardest hit countries to ensure girls can live Determined, Resilient, Empowered, AIDS-free, Mentored and Safe Lives

Key Population Services

- Test & Start, High-Impact Prevention including PREP, Civil Society Engagement

Find, Cure, Prevent TB

- "Bending the Curve: Optimize TB/HIV treatment, reduce incidence; Combat MDR TB; Expand Infection Control; Improve Pediatric Dx & Tx, Strengthen Labs & Data

WORKING SMARTER

Population HIV Impact Assessments (PHIAs)

- Expand 'Next Generation' population surveys including HIV prevalence, incidence, service utilization, treatment results, pediatric data

PEPFAR COP & POART Impact

- Support COP15 Pivots, COP16, POARTs, COP17 planning, TA/TC Approaches, Enhanced Partner Management

ICPI: Interagency Collaborative for Program Improvement

- Expand analysis and use of routinely collected data to track progress and inform decision-making

CMAS III & Site Improvement through Monitoring System (SIMS) &

- Complete CMAS 3.0 for Business, Strategy, L&M
- Complete and utilize SIMS2.0 and update SIMS3.0

- People Living with HIV: **37 MILLION**
- New Infections Each Year: **2 MILLION**
- Deaths Each Year: **1.2 MILLION**
- People on HIV Treatment: **16 MILLION**

- People Infected with TB: **2 BILLION (1/3 of World Population)**
- Sick with Active TB: **9.6 MILLION**
- New Cases of Multi-Drug Resistant TB (MDR): **480,000**
- Lives Saved: **37 MILLION**
