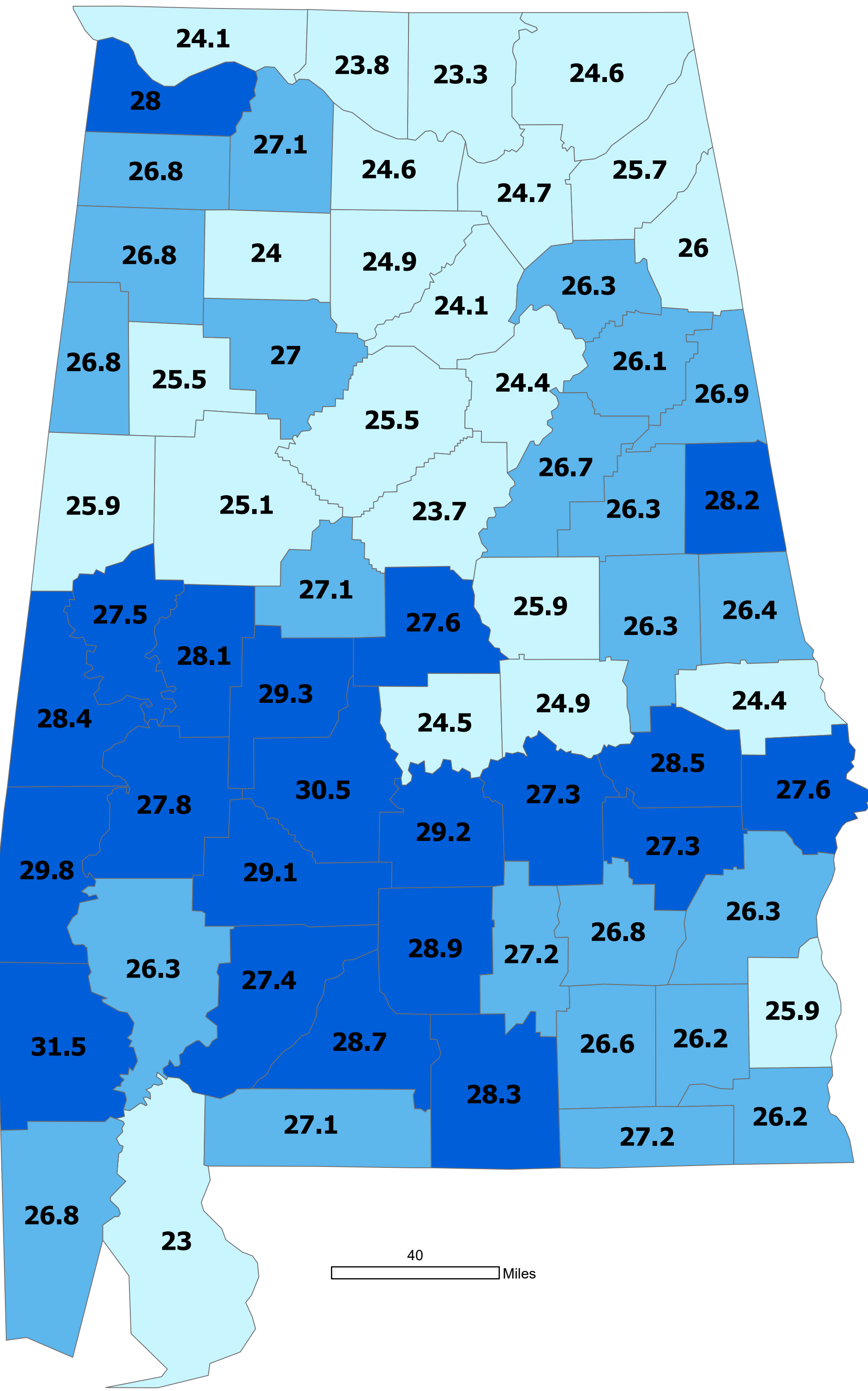
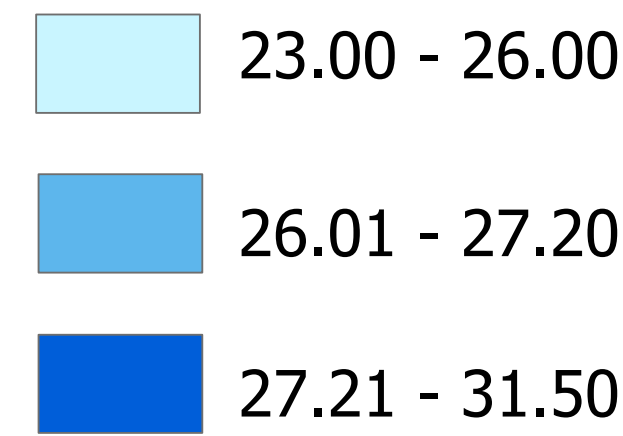


Counties with highest levels of blood pressure medication non-adherence and poverty have limited access* to Federally Qualified Health Care Centers (FQHCs)

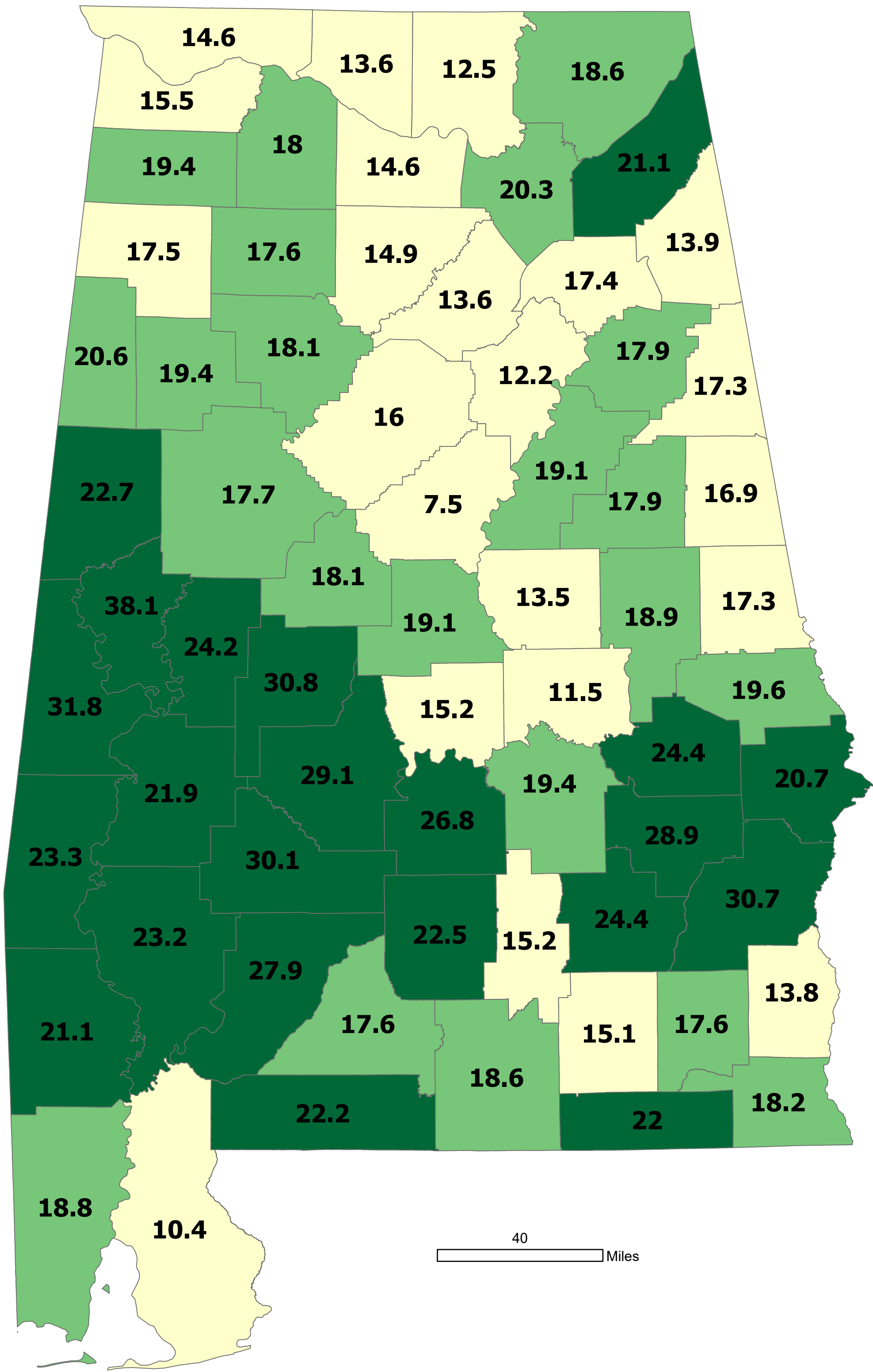
Blood Pressure Medication Non-Adherence



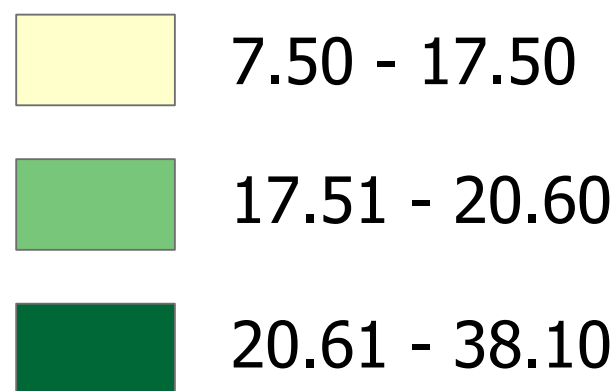

Medicare Beneficiaries (%)



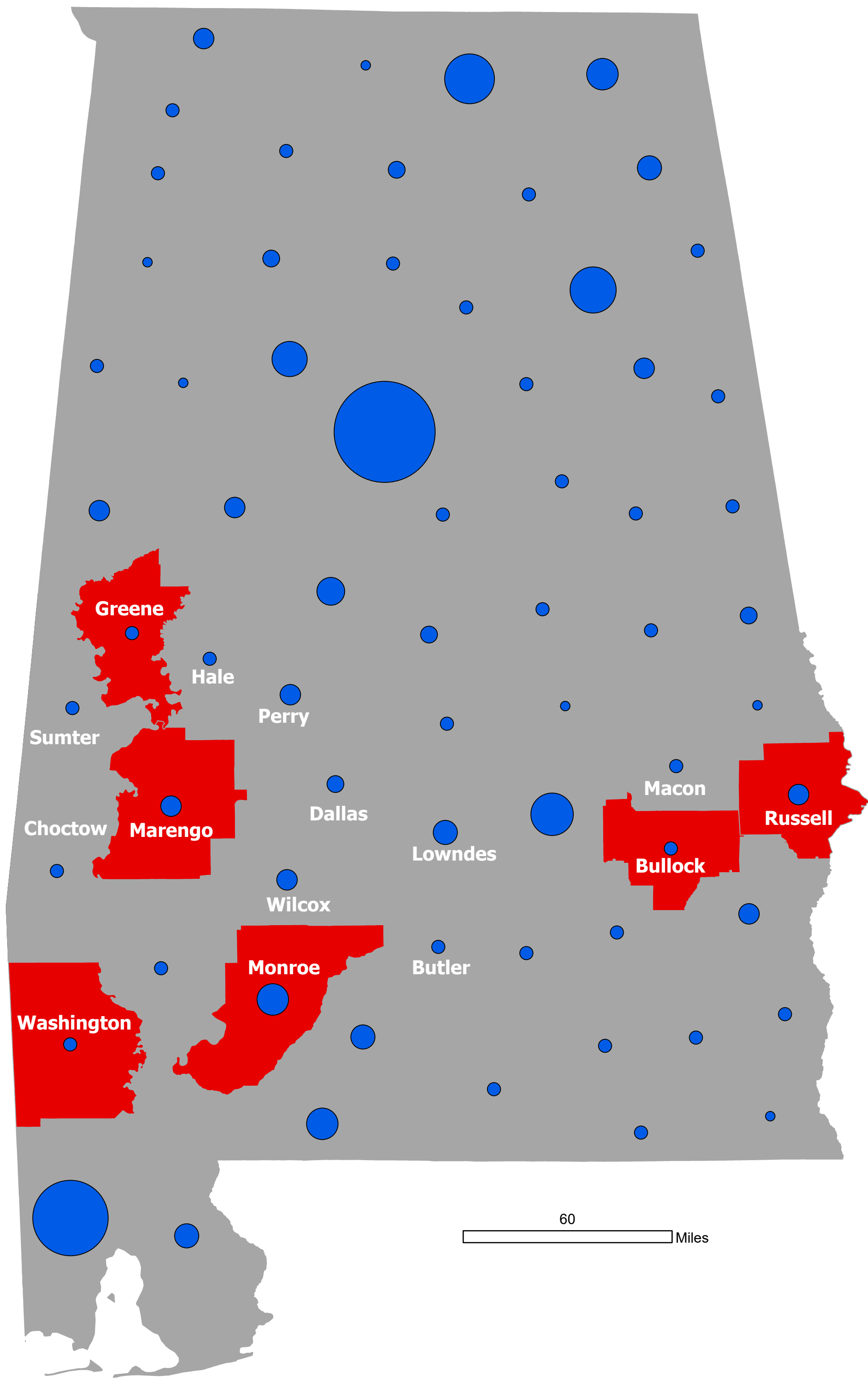

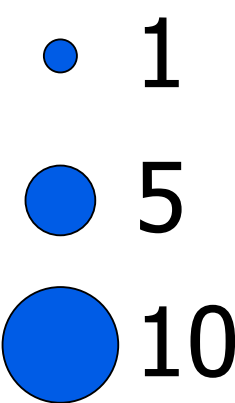
Population with income below poverty level
