

Major Cardiovascular Disease Mortality Rates by Colorado Counties: Identifying Areas of Need, 2002-2006





Major cardiovascular death rates per 100,000 age-adjusted to the 2000 U.S. standard population.

Interpretation-

Ten counties were above the U.S. rate of 289.5. Twenty-seven of Colorado's 64 counties were above the state average rate of 247.5.

These data suggest areas where prevention and treatment of cardiovascular disease are most needed.
