
## Hypertension Control among Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs) and Hypertension Death Rates by County, Florida



<sup>\*\*</sup>Hypertension control: hypertensive patients with blood pressure < 140/90. Each county score represents the average of the scores of all FQHCs in the county. A total of 45 out of 47 FQHCs were geocoded using the United States Census Bureau geocoder. The state-level hypertension control by Florida FQHCs in 2017 was 57%.
