
## Children in Kentucky: Analyzing Indicators for Improved Health



The goal of this map was to examine indicators that could have an impact on the health of children in Kentucky.

Darker graduated colors on the map represent a greater percentage of houses that were built between 1939-1979, thus increasing the chance of the house containing lead-based paint.

This map can be used to inform decision making, such as exploring more healthy homes inspectors, especially in darker shaded areas, which have a higher percentage of houses considered at risk, along with the encouragement of more tobacco free schools.
