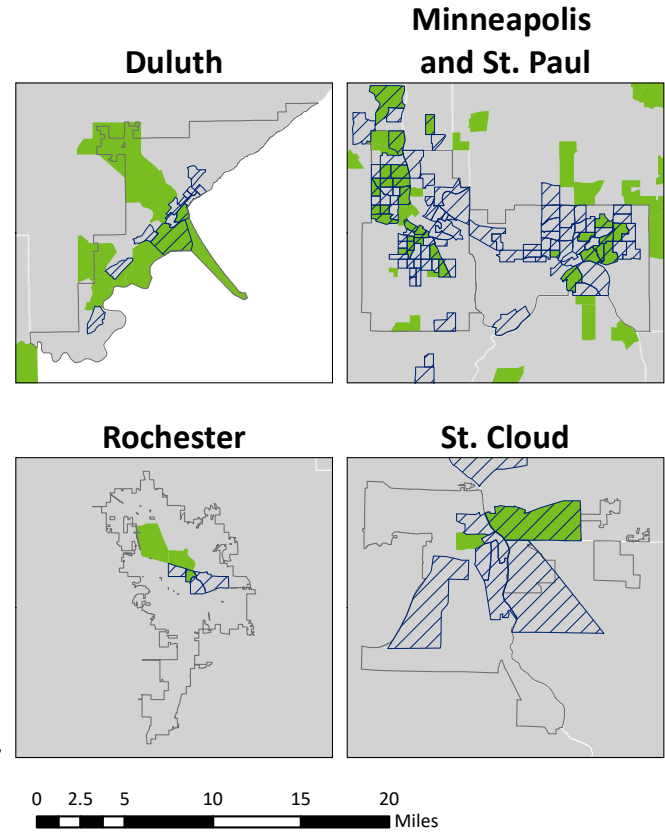
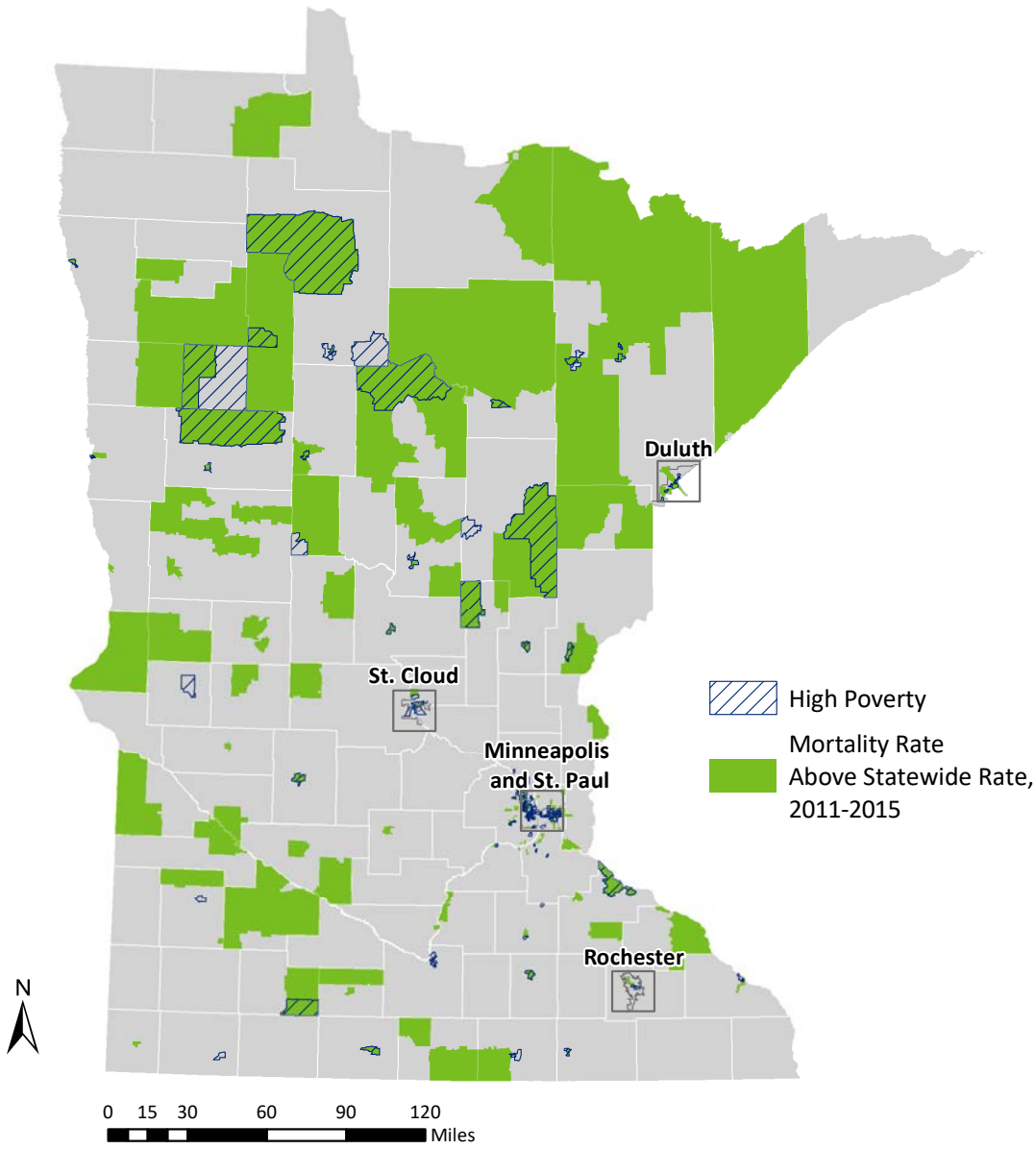


High Poverty and High Heart Disease and Stroke Mortality Rates Under Age 75
