

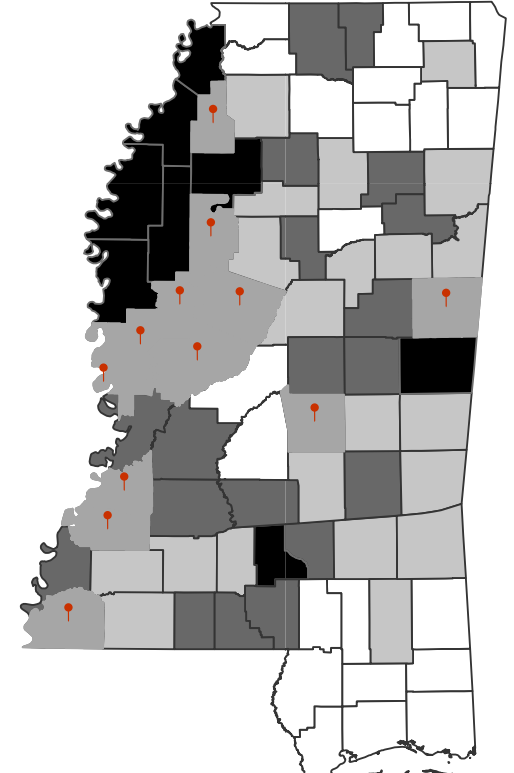

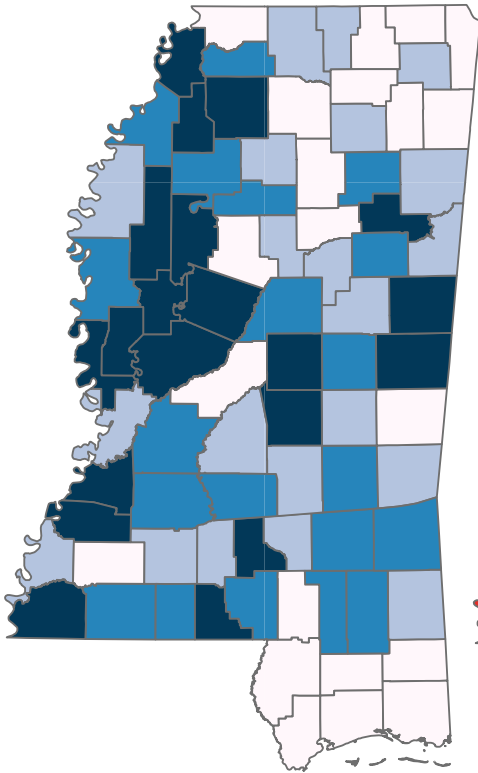

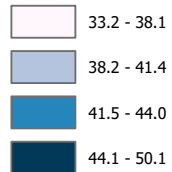

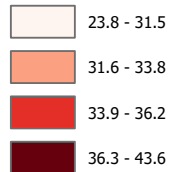

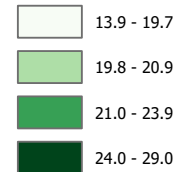
Obesity age-adjusted prevalence (%)



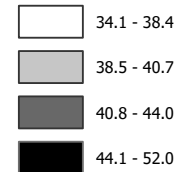
Physical inactivity age-adjusted prevalence (%)
