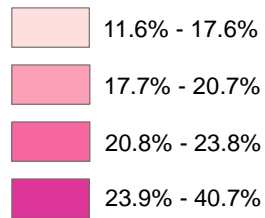


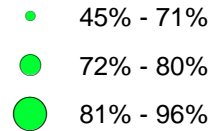
Percentage of Women Not Screened for Breast Cancer and Proportion of Uninsured Women Not Served by the Cancer Services Program by County, 2013-2014

Percent Unscreened*

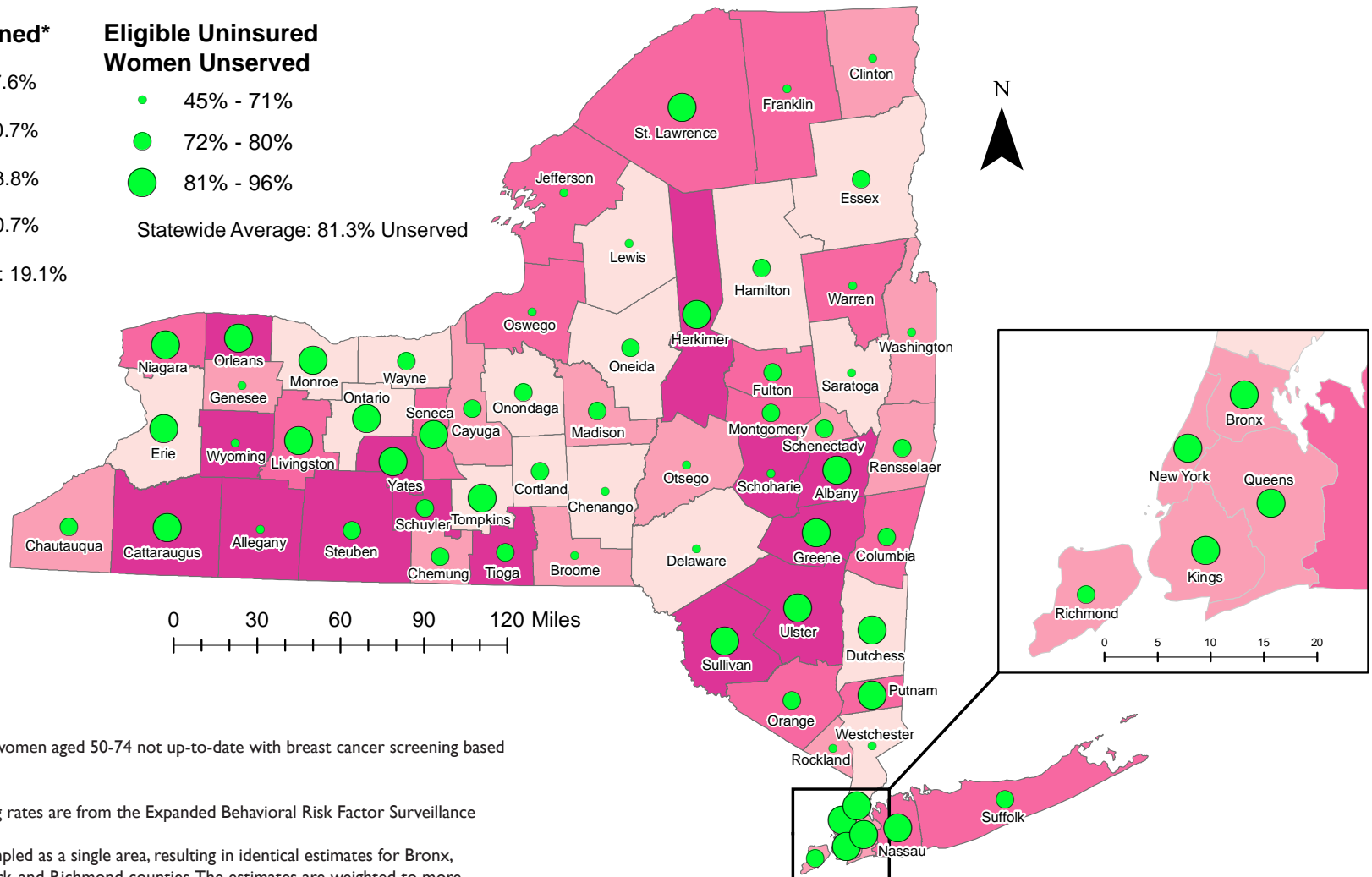


Statewide Estimate: 19.1%

Data sources: Screening rates are from the Expanded Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System, 2013-14. New York City was sampled as a single area, resulting in identical estimates for Bronx, Queens, Kings, New York, and Richmond counties. The estimates are weighted to more accurately represent the adult population living in each county. The proportion of eligible uninsured women unserved is calculated as 1 minus the number of women who received at least one Cancer Services Program-funded service in the 2013-14 program year divided by the estimated number of uninsured women ages 50-64 who were at or below 250% of the Federal Poverty Limit based on Small Area Health Insurance Estimates (SAHIE) for 2013.
