



# EVALUATING THE REACH OF HEALTH SYSTEMS PARTICIPATING IN A CDC FUNDED GRANT (1815) FOR GREATER PHILADELPHIA

THIS MAP SHOWS ALL PARTICIPATING 1815 HEALTH SYSTEMS IN GREATER PHILADELPHIA ALONG WITH POPULATION WEIGHTED CENTROIDS (PWC). THESE HEALTH SYSTEMS ARE PARTICIPATING IN A CDC-FUNDED QUALITY IMPROVEMENT INITIATIVE TO IMPROVE THE DIAGNOSIS AND TREATMENT OF HIGH BLOOD PRESSURE, HIGH CHOLESTEROL, AND DIABETES. THERE IS ONE PWC PER CENSUS TRACT. PWC DEMONSTRATE POPULATION DENSITY AND ARE USEFUL IN DETERMINING RELATIVE DISTANCE TO A SPECIFIC LOCATION OR LOCATIONS ON A TOTAL POPULATION BASIS. AREAS WITH MORE DOTS ARE MORE DENSELY POPULATED. GREEN CENTROIDS ARE WITHIN 5 MILES OF AN 1815 HEALTH SYSTEM AND INCLUDE 541,116 PEOPLE. BLUE DOTS ARE MORE THAN 5 MILES FROM AN 1815 HEALTH SYSTEM AND INCLUDE 1,023,929 PEOPLE.
