
Drive Times to Community Pharmacies and Blood Pressure Medication Adherence* among Adults Aged 18 and Older, by Vermont Town, 2014-2016

[^] Low adherence are towns with less 75.5% of persons at least 80% adherent*. Limited pharamacy access are towns whose town center is greater than a 15-minutes drive to a community pharmacy.
