
Blood Pressure Medication Nonadherence* Among Wisconsin Medicaid Members by County and Pharmacy Locations

*Blood pressure medication nonadherence determined when a Medicaid member (18-64 years old) has less than 80% proportion of days covered (PDC) with blood pressure medications or does not meet the PDC threshold (>=80%) as recommended by Pharmacy Quality Alliance for reasonable likelihood of achieving most of the potential clinical benefit.
