Adding and Adjusting a Basemap's Transparency

Adding a Basemap:

- 1. Open a recent project or begin a new one with a map template
- 2. Select the Map tab on the ribbon
- 3. Select the Basemap icon on the layer portion of the ribbon
 - a. Basemap options will populate below
- 4. Select a Basemap to use for your map
 - a. Notice that some of the Basemaps contain multiple layers, while some only have one

Adjusting a Layer's Transparency:

- 1. Select the layer to be adjusted in the table of contents
 - a. Notice the Appearance tab on the ribbon after selecting the layer
- 2. Select the Appearance tab on the ribbon
- 3. Use the sliding fader or percentage field in the effects section of the ribbon to adjust the layer's transparency
