Update on the National Survey of Residential Care Facilities (NSRCF)

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NSRCF Purpose

- Provide objective source of nationally representative data to policy-makers, researchers, industry and consumers about facilities, services, and residents
- Complement other federal surveys and fill a significant information gap about a major portion of long-term care providers and users

Sample Eligibility Criteria

Eligible residential care facilities are places that:

- are licensed, registered, listed, certified, or otherwise regulated by the state;
- provide room and board with at least two meals a day;
- provide around-the-clock on-site supervision;
- help with personal care such as bathing and dressing or health-related services such as medication management;
- serve an adult population.

Facilities licensed to serve the mentally ill or the MR/DD populations exclusively are excluded.

Primary Goals and Instrument Domains

- Estimate size of the industry
 - Number of residential care places in the US
 - Number of residents
- Determine characteristics of facilities
 - Geographic distribution
 - Structure and environment
 - ◆ Types of services offered
 - Types of staff who are employed
 - Policies on admission and discharge

Primary Goals and Instrument Domains (2)

- Determine the characteristics of residents
 - Demographics
 - Level of functional disability and cognitive impairment
 - Health conditions
 - Service needs
 - Services used
 - ◆ Charges

Survey Administration

- In-person
- Facility questionnaire conducted with facility administrator
- Resident questionnaire conducted with a staff member knowledgeable about each selected resident
