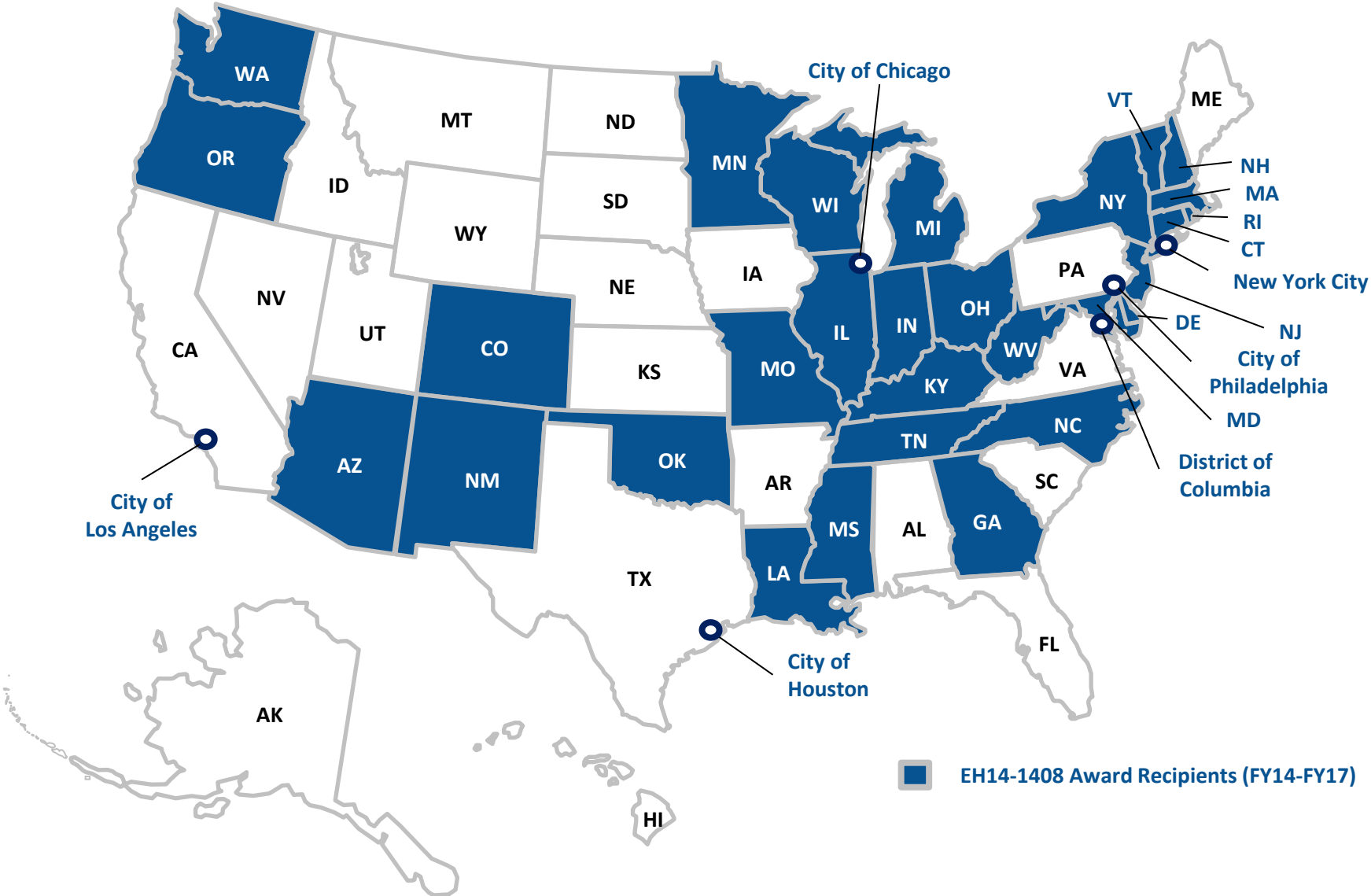


# Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Programs Funded During FY14-FY17
