#### **Editorial:**

It is our privilege to introduce the first issue of the *GTSS News*. The purpose of the Global Tobacco Surveillance System (GTSS) is to enhance countries' capacity to monitor tobacco use, guide national tobacco prevention and control programs, and facilitate comparison of tobacco-related data at the national, regional, and global levels. The *GTSS News* will be issued quarterly and it aims to provide news updates and foster communication among regions.
