Passage of the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 has brought with it a number of service programs from the Federal Government . . . including services from the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH). NIOSH is a component of the Public Health Service, U.S. Department of Health, Education, and Welfare.

Hazard Evaluations Performed at Your Worksite

Employers and employees covered by the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 are eligible to submit requests for on-site evaluations of potentially toxic substances used or found on the job. The Hazard Evaluation Program of NIOSH is strictly a service function. It is not part of an enforcement activity.
