

Regulatory Actions, Recalls, and Results of Product Testing

January 23, 2010

Daniele International Inc., recalls 1.3 million pounds of ready-to-eat (RTE) salami products

January 31, 2010

Daniele expands recall to include 17,000 pounds of RTE products

February 4, 2010

Daniele recall updated to include two additional RTE salami products, adding 24,000 pounds to the January 23 recall

February 16, 2010

Daniele recall expands to include approximately 115,000 pounds of RTE salami products

February 23, 2010

RI Dept of Health identifies outbreak strain from unopened container of *crushed red pepper* provided by Wholesome Spice used in production of Daniele's RTE salami products

February 25, 2010

Wholesome Spice recalls all lots of 25 lb containers of *crushed red* pepper sold between April 6, 2009 and January 20, 2010 <u>As a result of this recall</u>

March 5, 2010 Wholesome Spice expands recall to include ground red pepper and whole black pepper

Jan 15 – Feb 16, 2010

Outbreak strain identified in 8 salami products (6 open, 2 sealed packages)

Jan 23 – March 30, 2010

Period of Recalls & Regulatory Actions

March 4, 2010

RI Dept of Health identifies outbreak strain from unopened containers of *whole black pepper* supplied by Wholesome Spice and Mincing Overseas Spice Co. used in production of Daniele's RTE salami products

March 5, 2010

Mincing Overseas Spice Co. recalls two different lots of *black pepper* sold in 50 lb, 25 lb, and 20 lb containers
