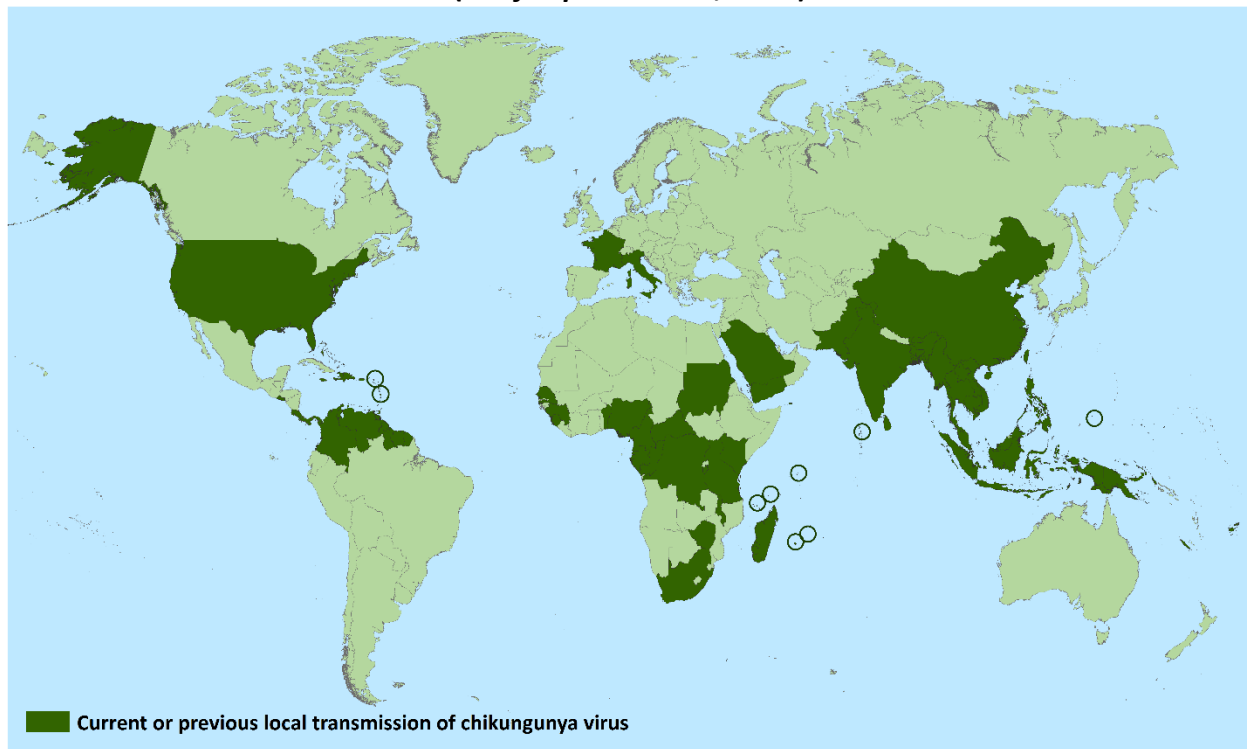


**Countries and territories where chikungunya cases have been reported\***
