\* Each facility reported influenza vaccination coverage among nursing home residents each week. To approximate cumulative vaccination coverage over the influenza season, influenza vaccination coverage among nursing home residents reported by nursing homes for the week of March 30, 2025, were used for analysis. Each facility reported summary influenza vaccination data among health care personnel working in the facility for  $\geq 1$  day during October 1, 2024–March 31, 2025.
