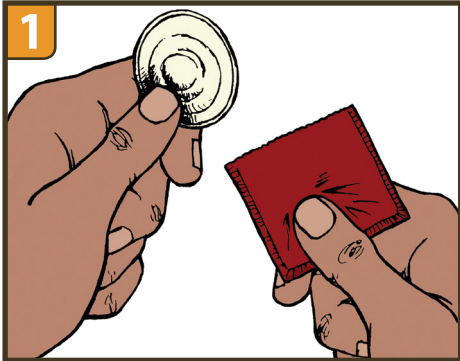


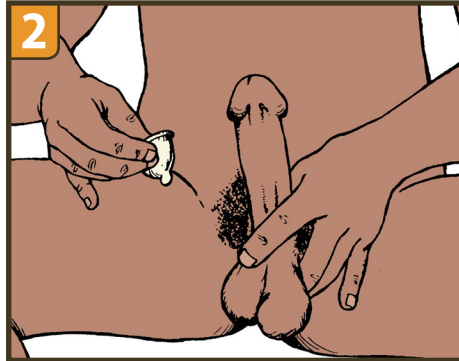

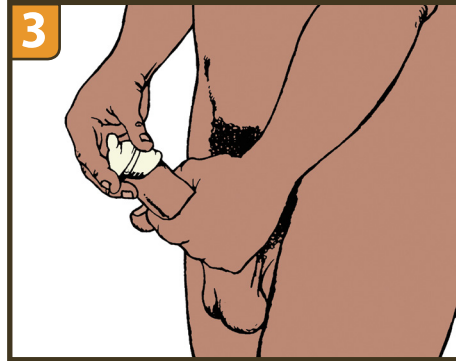
Ebola Survivors: How to Use a Male Condom



1 Carefully open and remove the condom.



2 Use the condom when the penis is hard.



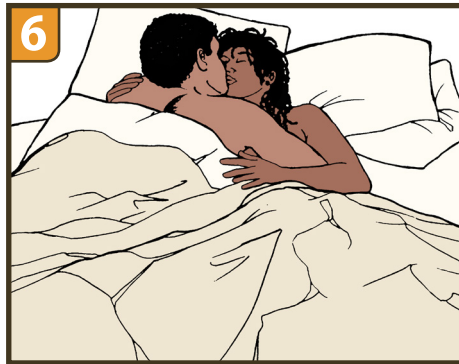
3 Place condom on penis head.



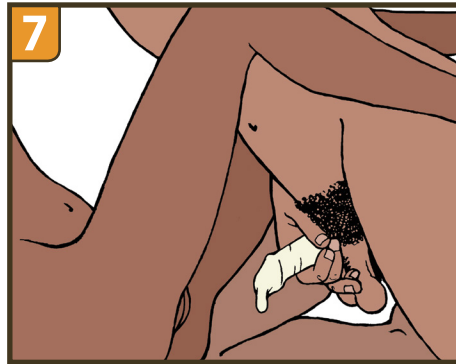
4 Pinch air out of the tip of the condom.



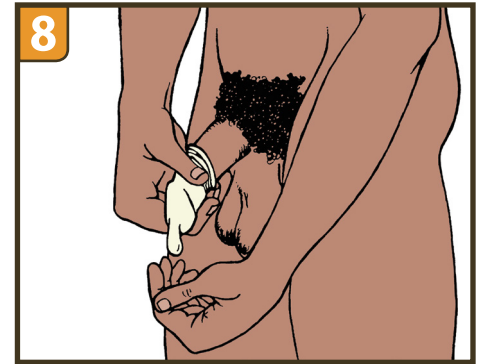
5 Unroll the condom all the way down the penis.



6 Use a condom every time you have sex.



7 After sex, the survivor should hold condom on the bottom of the penis and pull out of the vagina.



8 The survivor should remove the condom and throw it away.

- After sex, **only** the Ebola survivor should touch the used condom.
- After touching used condoms, wash your hands with soap and water for 40-60 seconds. You can use an alcohol-based hand rub for 20-30 seconds if soap and water are not available. If hands are visibly dirty, use soap and water.
- **Never** reuse condoms. **Never** use two condoms at the same time.
- If any symptoms of Ebola develop within 21 days after contact with semen from a man who has had Ebola, **get care immediately**.
