

RECOGNIZE

• Ill traveler (see back of card).

ISOLATE

- Separate the ill traveler from others to the extent possible.
- Use appropriate personal protective equipment such as face mask, gloves, and face shield or goggles if you have close contact (within one meter) with the ill traveler.

NOTIFY

 Your supervisor or follow your port's procedures to request a medical evaluation or assistance.

GIVE SUPPORT

 Follow instructions from the port or public health authority.



Look for or ask about Ebola symptoms.* An ill traveler may be denied boarding.

Alert your supervisor about any traveler who has:

FEVER of 100.4°F/38°C or higher (including history of feeling feverish)

ONE or more of the following conditions:

- Severe headache Diarrhea
- Muscle pain
- Stomach pain

Vomiting

Unexplained bruising or bleeding
