# If Someone Gets Sick at School

#### These are the symptoms of Ebola. If you have any of these symptoms, call 117.





Diarrhea



Headache



Vomiting





**Muscle Pain** 

#### Teachers and staff should know what to do if someone at school has a fever higher than 38°C.



### Isolate and Contact

Keep the sick person at least 1 meter (3 feet) away from other students, teachers, and staff.

- Do not touch the sick person, blood, or body fluids.
- Remember to always wash your hands with soap and water.
- Contact family, if a student.

## **Ask and Alert**

Find out if the sick person has been

- Near someone who has had symptoms like Ebola.
  - Ask family to pick them up.
  - Call or have the family call 117.
- Told by health authorities that they have been around someone with Ebola.
  - o Alert the closest Ebola response team.





## Transfer

Ask for consent to transfer to Ebola Treatment Unit.

- If permission given, contact the response team.
- If permission not given, alert authorities.



### **Clean and Disinfect**

Clean and disinfect the area according to cleaning guidance.
