Arboviral Disease HL7 Case Notification Message Update



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The CDC Message Mapping Guide (MMG) development team has finalized and posted the new Arboviral v1.3 MMG at https://wwwn.cdc.gov/nndss/case-notification/message-mappingguides.html. The new Arboviral v1.3 MMG will support Zika-related case notifications and all other Arboviral disease notifications. The team plans to host a webinar, in conjunction with the CDC Arboviral Program, on 4/14/16 to review the revisions and answer questions about the recently updated guide.

NNDSS staff also are updating the NNDSS case definition website to incorporate CSTE's Interim Position Statement #16-ID-01-Interim titled "Zika Virus Disease and Congenital Zika Virus Infection Interim Case Definition and Addition to the Nationally Notifiable List" and will send a notice when updates are complete.

The updated expected timeline is as follows:

- Updated (v1.3) Arboviral message mapping guide: Now available.
- Message Quality Framework (MQF) updated to test the new message: April 2016.
- CDC systems ready to accept the new messages: June 2016.

MESSAGE MAPPING GUIDE DEVELOPMENT UPDATES

Six Priority MMGs Update: In March 2016, the CDC MMG development team posted the final version of the Generic v2 MMG and the latest pilot test-ready versions of the Hepatitis, STD, and Congenital Syphilis MMGs to the new NNDSS HL7 Case Notification Resource Center at

https://wwwn.cdc.gov/nndss/case-notification/. The team expects to post the pilot test-ready Mumps and Pertussis MMGs in April 2016.

Varicella MMG Update: The MMG development team

expects to post a draft version of the Varicella MMG for a 30-day external review by public health jurisdictions, partners, and stakeholders in April 2016.

New MMGs Identified for Development in 2016: The MMG development team currently is analyzing the proposed data elements provided by the programs for Malaria, Babesiosis, Measles, Rubella and Congenital Rubella Syndrome for MMG development. The team anticipates beginning work with the programs for Cyclosporiasis and Trichinellosis on MMG development in the spring.

MESSAGE VALIDATION, PROCESSING, AND PROVISIONING SYSTEM UPDATES

MVPS Completed UAT for Generic v2 and Hepatitis: The CDC Message Validation, Processing, and Provisioning System (MVPS) team completed several MVPS User Acceptance Training (UAT) activities in March 2016:

• NMI pilot jurisdictions and CDC programs participated in a UAT training session on 3/9/16. The 1-hour training covered UAT expectations and activities for testers to ensure a productive testing experience. The



training also demoed the latest versions of the Message Evaluation and Testing Service (METS) and MVPS (deployed in the UAT environment).

- UAT began on 3/14/16, and concluded on 3/25/16. During the first week, pilot jurisdictions tested METS and the MVPS Dashboard features (message processing, user management, and security roles). During the second week, CDC programs tested the MVPS Dashboard features. A set of program testers also participated in data provisioning testing.
- Participating jurisdictions and CDC programs submitted potential defects, enhancements, and feedback on METS and MVPS. The MVPS team hosted daily tester touchpoint calls for all participants to discuss their UAT findings and ask questions related to their testing experience. The MVPS testing support team met daily to review submitted defects and enhancements from testers. The MVPS development team is currently reviewing and prioritizing identified defects and enhancements for MVPS implementation.

TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE UPDATES

NMI eSHARE Hosted Two Webinars in March:

 On 3/3/16, CDC hosted a special eSHARE event that provided an overview of the CDC Lab Test Algorithm



for Arboviral diseases and electronic laboratory reporting (ELR) vocabulary for Zika.

• On 3/17/16, CDC hosted an eSHARE session that provided an overview of NMI Implementation and Technical Assistance Tools. The panel featured six



jurisdictions that participated in piloting the Generic v2 and Hepatitis MMGs; panelists shared their experiences, the TA tools that they found most helpful, and lessons learned. This information will help other jurisdictions prepare to implement these first two message mapping guides when they are available.
