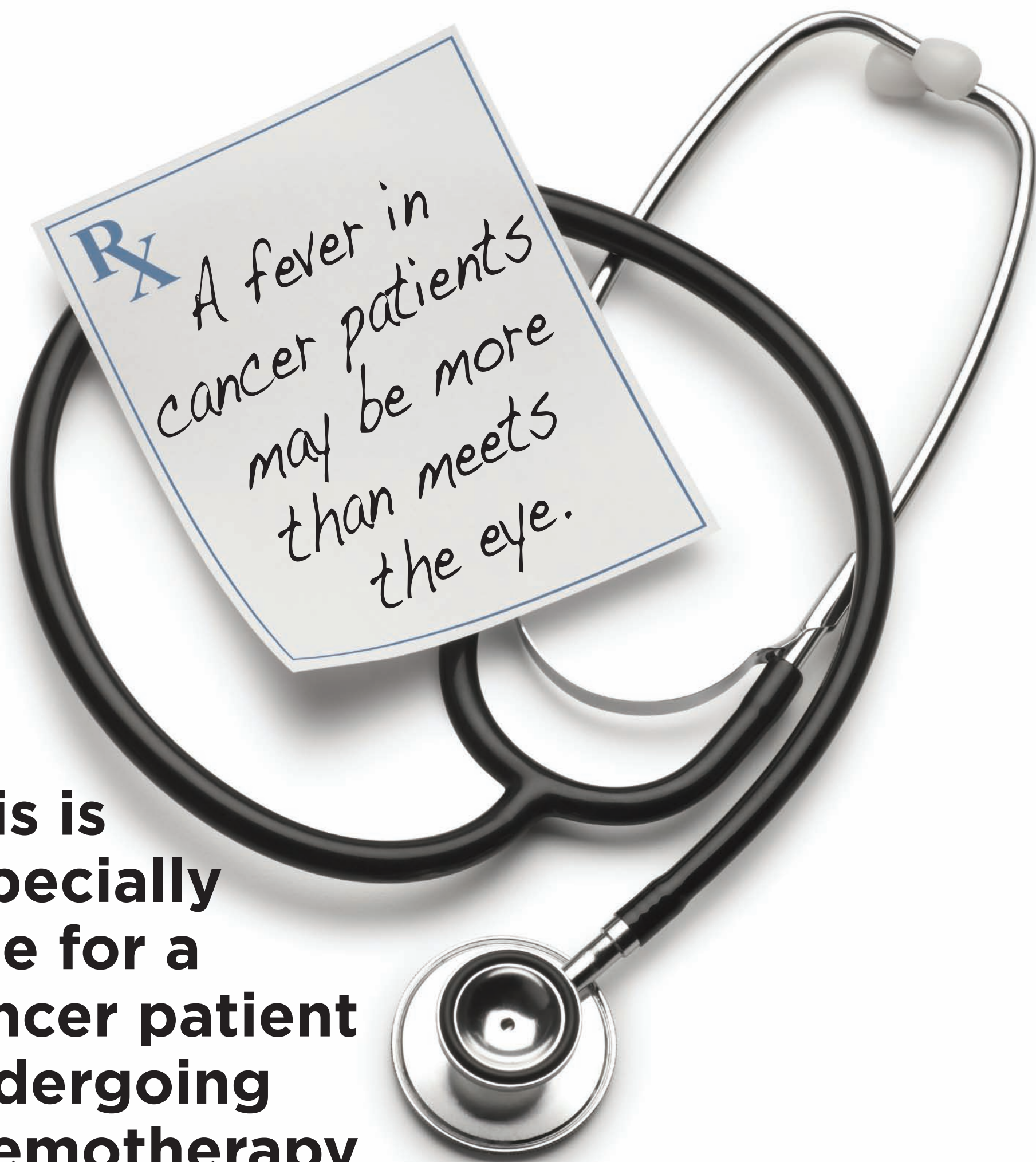


EMERGENCY ROOM PERSONNEL
