February NMI eSHARE to Highlight NMI Implementation

- The February NMI eSHARE webinar, "Implementation Preparation 101," will provide detailed information on how jurisdictions can best prepare for implementing the Generic v2 and Hepatitis case notification messages. The event will be held on Tuesday, 2/21/17, at 3:00 PM EST.
- The first NMI eSHARE session of 2017, held on 1/17/17, highlighted lessons learned from the recent NMI onboarding of pilot states. The January webinar also provided updates on the NMI Technical Assistance and Training Resource Center, recent minor changes to the Generic v2 and Hepatitis Message Mapping Guides (MMGs), and arboviral onboarding.

NMI Technical Assistance and Onboarding Status

When multiple NMI pilot states have successfully onboarded the Message Validation, Processing, and Provisioning System (MVPS), CDC expects to open NMI technical assistance and onboarding to all jurisdictions for Generic v2 and Hepatitis and launch the NMI Technical Assistance and Training Resource Center in February. More details will be provided soon.

MVPS Updates

- The team completed development work for MVPS 2.2.3 on 1/20/17, which includes the following system updates:
 - Updates to select processing warning and error messages (including Morbidity and Mortality Weekly Report [MMWR] Year, MMWR Week, Date/Time of Birth, and Patient Age Units).
 - Updates to user management functionality (including minor updates to the Jurisdiction and Condition dropdown lists to remove duplicates).

- MVPS is implementing Rhapsody to improve system code manageability and overall development efficiency.
- The NMI team encourages all non-pilot jurisdictions to complete the Secure Access
 Management Services (SAMS) proofing process and confirm their access with the MVPS
 support team. More information about SAMS access and training may be found on the NMI

Template Being Developed for Occupation and Industry Data in MMGs

- The CDC MMG team is collaborating with the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health to develop a template that will be incorporated into MMGs to support the collection of occupation and industry information as standardized data elements.
- Future work with health departments and CDC programs will explore how to standardize more specific occupational exposure information.

HL7 CASE NOTIFICATION MESSAGES IN PRODUCTION

Arboviral v1.3

 The NMI onboarding team is working with South Dakota to onboard Arboviral v1.3.

Generic v2

- On 1/18/17, the NMI team approved Michigan to go into production for Generic v2. Other states in the onboarding process include Florida, New York, and Minnesota. The NMI team anticipates that California will begin the onboarding process in late January/early February.
- Jurisdictions may use the Message Evaluation and Testing Service (METS) to test their Generic v2 messages by accessing https://mets.cdc.gov. For more information on METS, please visit https://www.cdc.gov/nmi/mets.html.

Hepatitis

- On 1/18/17, the NMI team approved Michigan to go into production for Hepatitis. Other states in the onboarding process for Hepatitis include Florida, Minnesota, and Idaho. The NMI team anticipates that California will begin the onboarding process in late January/early February.

HL7 CASE NOTIFICATION MESSAGES IN DEVELOPMENT

Babesiosis (Stage 1—Draft)

 CDC updated the guide with unique identifiers received from standard development organizations and the appropriate value set links after requesting value set updates to the Vocabulary Access and Distribution System



Congenital Syphilis and STD MMGs (Stage II—Pilot Testready)

- · CDC is currently updating the Congenital Syphilis and STD MMGs.
- The CDC program supported the implementation of the Antimicrobial Susceptibility Data Element block and lab template in the STD MMG.
- The program also supported the development of the lab interpretative diagnostic data elements and valid values and the Gender Identity and Sexual Orientation elements in the STD MMG based upon the HHS Office of the National Coordinator for Health Information Technology standard.

Foodborne and Diarrheal Disease (FDD) MMG (Requirements Analysis)

 The CDC MMG team has analyzed the FDD MMG and will recommend to the CDC program some changes to the FDD MMG to make it consistent with other NMI MMGs.



· CDC is assigning vocabulary codes for clinical data elements.

Malaria MMG (Stage I—Draft)

· The MMG team has made all updates identified by the program from the external review and subsequent meetings.

Measles MMG (Stage I-Draft)

· The MMG team proposed a lab epi-interpretative data elements template that could be used across all of the guides based upon the Measles MMG work.

Mumps and Pertussis MMGs (Stage II—Pilot Test-ready)

· Pilot test-ready Mumps and Pertussis guides and artifacts are available on the NNDSS HL7 Case Notification Resource Center at https://wwwn.cdc.gov/nndss/case-notification/.

Rubella and Congenital Rubella Syndrome (CRS) MMGs (Stage I—Draft)

· The MMG team is working to resolve issues related to the external review comments/feedback and general issues identified with the CRS and Rubella draft artifacts.

Trichinellosis (Requirements Analysis)

· The MMG team is reviewing the data element list with the CDC program to gain approval of the finalized data element list.


Varicella MMG (Stage I-Draft)
