


Usual source of health care by type of health insurance, ages ≥ 65 years


Doctor checked cholesterol within past 2 years by type of health insurance, ages 18–64 years


Dental visit in past year by type of health insurance, ages 18–64 years


Doctor checked cholesterol within past 2 years by type of health insurance, ages ≥ 65 years
