Per the North America Industrial Classification Standard (NAICS), other exports are defined as waste, used merchandise, and special classification. Data for the first 4 categories were downloaded from the International Trade Administration's Trade Policy Information System (TPIS) website by selecting the health security priority countries and selecting: <http://tpis1.trade.gov>.<sup>20</sup> Then, the data were summed and the value of "exported" services added (where available). Service data are available only for countries where the United States has trade agreements or presence ( $n=10$ ).
