#### Accelerated Message Mapping Guide (MMG) Development Strategy Implemented

- CDC is pleased to report that its recent MMG Acceleration Pilot Project successfully reduced the time required to develop a pilot-ready MMG from more than 8 months to about 4 months.
- The project used intensive project management, an abbreviated MMG lifecycle, and the newly developed Message Mapping Guide Authoring Tool.
- Based on this success, CDC is incorporating these changes for MMG development going forward.

#### Arboviral v1.3

- There are 12 jurisdictions in production for arboviral.
- Nebraska and Washington are engaged in onboarding.

## **Developing HL7 Case Notification Messages**

#### Babesiosis MMG (Stage II—Pilot Test-ready)

- The MMG is ready for pilot testing and MVPS development.
- The NMI team scheduled a meeting with the CDC program to propose pilot states for the babesiosis MMG pilot process.
- It will be piloted in conjunction with the trichinellosis and malaria MMGs.

#### Carbapenemase-Producing Carbapenem-Resistant Enterobacteriaceae (CP-CRE) MMG (Requirements Analysis)

• CDC is reviewing and updating the guide internally.

#### Congenital Syphilis (CS) and STD MMGs (Stage III—Final MMG)

#### Foodborne and Diarrheal Disease (FDD) MMG (Stage II—Pilot Test-ready)

- CDC is finalizing the pilot test-ready versions of the test scenarios and test messages.
- The MVPS team has begun development work on the FDD MMG.

#### Lyme and Tickborne MMGs (Requirements Analysis)

• The MMG team has begun development work on the Lyme and tickborne MMGs.

#### Malaria MMG (Stage II—Pilot Test-ready)

- The MVPS team is completing development work on the malaria MMG.
- It will be piloted in conjunction with the babesiosis and trichinellosis MMGs.

#### Measles MMG (Stage I—Draft)

• CDC is reviewing the draft guide.

#### Mumps and Pertussis MMGs (Stage III—Final)

#### Respiratory and Invasive Bacterial Disease (RIBD) MMG (Requirements Analysis)

• CDC is developing the test scenario and test messages for the guide.

#### Rubella and Congenital Rubella Syndrome (CRS) MMGs (Stage I—Draft)

- CDC is resolving final value set issues in the CRS MMG that affect all vaccine-preventable disease guides.
- CDC completed test messages for both MMGs.

#### Trichinellosis (Pilot Test Ready—Accelerated Development Pilot)

- The MMG is ready for MVPS development.
- It will be piloted in conjunction with the babesiosis and malaria MMGs.

# Tuberculosis (TB) and Latent Tuberculosis Infection (LTBI) MMG (External Review—Accelerated Development Pilot)

- CDC completed the pilot test-ready MMG and associated artifacts at the end of May.
- The MVPS team has begun development work on the TB/LTBI MMG.
- CDC expects to begin pilot testing this summer.

#### Varicella MMG (Stage III—Final)
