

## dementia caregiving in arizona


## DATA FROM THE 2016 BEHAVIORAL RISK FACTOR SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM

In Arizona, <u>more than half</u> of all adults providing unpaid care to loved ones with Alzheimer's or another dementia have been doing so for at least two years.

<u>Nearly half</u> of Alzheimer's and dementia caregivers provide 20 or more hours of care per week.


Almost 40 percent of Alzheimer's and dementia caregivers provide care to their parent or their parent-in-law.
