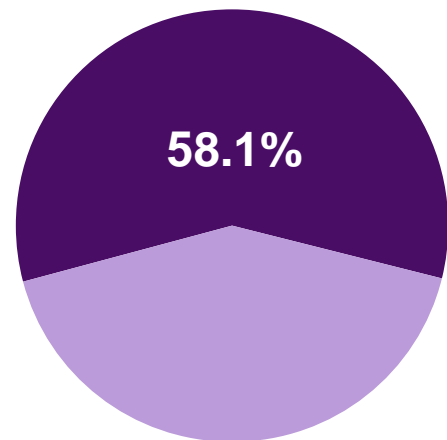
DATA FROM THE 2016 BEHAVIORAL RISK FACTOR SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM

In South Dakota, nearly 60 percent of all adults providing unpaid care to loved ones with Alzheimer's or another dementia have been doing so for at least two years.

Among Alzheimer's and dementia caregivers, 60 percent are men, and more than one-third provide care to their parent or their parent-in-law.

Nearly half of Alzheimer's and dementia caregivers provide burdensome personal care, such as feeding or bathing.

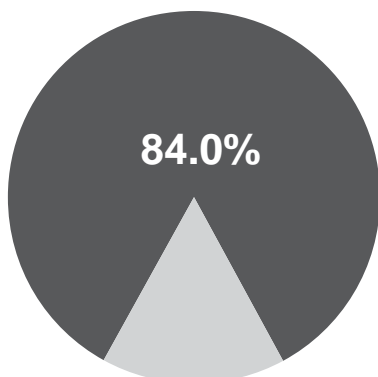
Percent of dementia caregivers providing care for at least 2 years
