

In Iowa, <u>more than one-third</u> of all adults providing unpaid care to loved ones with Alzheimer's or another dementia have been doing so for at least two years.


<u>One in five</u> of Alzheimer's and dementia caregivers provide 20 or more hours of care per week.


Percent of dementia caregivers providing help with specific tasks
