Here are the facts about getting tested:

TESTS CAN BE FREE OR LOW COST. It all depends on where you go. Check out CDC.gov/ActAgainstAIDS to search for free testing centers near you.

THERE ARE DIFFERENT KINDS OF TESTS. Some are blood tests, while others use a sample of oral fluid from your mouth. Depending on the test, you could get your results in 20 minutes or may need to return to the clinic to get your results.

TESTS CAN BE ANONYMOUS AND/OR CONFIDENTIAL.

YOU CAN BRING A FRIEND with you. It might help to have someone you trust to talk to, especially if you're nervous about getting tested.

Anonymous means your name doesn't go on your test weans results. Confidential means your name does go on your your name does go expt your name they're kept results but they're kept results like all medical records.
