# Meningococcal Work Group Activities

- Updated the Work Group Terms of Reference
- Reviewing updated data on meningococcal disease epidemiology:
  - College students
  - Infants and young children
- Reviewing newly available data for MenB vaccines.
  - Antibody persistence and response to a booster dose
  - Safety and immunogenicity of MenB vaccines in children aged <10 years
- Reviewing and grading evidence for booster doses of MenB vaccine for persons at increased risk

# Timeline of Upcoming Activities

- June 2018: Complete GRADE evaluation for MenB booster dose (tentative)
- October 2018: Full session on a single MenB booster dose in persons aged  $\geq 10$  at increased risk (tentative)
- Late 2018/early 2019: Publication of consolidated ACIP Recommendation and Report on Meningococcal Vaccines (MenACWY and MenB)
