Work Group Terms of Reference

- Consider the evidence for recommendations that would allow any tetanus and diphtheria toxoid-containing vaccine (Tdap or Td) to be used for:
 - Decennial Td booster in adults
 - Tetanus prophylaxis as needed for wound management

Issues being considered by ACIP Pertussis Vaccines Work Group

- Previous ACIP work group discussed repeat Tdap vaccinations in 2013 and 2014
- Tdap products currently licensed for a single use
- A new Pertussis Vaccines Work Group convened
 - Potential FDA label change(s)
 - Additional programmatic changes

- Should the current recommendation that non-pregnant adults receive a single lifetime dose of Tdap and Td boosters every 10 years be changed to allow any Td-containing vaccine (Tdap or Td) to be used for the decennial Td booster in adults?
- Should any Td-containing vaccine (Tdap or Td) be allowed for use for tetanus prophylaxis in the setting of wound management?
