

SPAIN—*Cadiz*.—Month of February, 1912. Population, 67,306. Total number of deaths from all causes 194, including smallpox 5, tuberculosis 16.

Huelva.—Month of February, 1912. Population, 28,982. Total number of deaths from all causes 102, including measles 13, tuberculosis 10.

TAHITI.—Four weeks ended March 18, 1912. Population, 4,000. Total number of deaths from all causes 6. No deaths from contagious diseases.

URUGUAY—*Montevideo*.—Month of January, 1912. Population, 321,224. Total number of deaths from all causes 538, including diphtheria 2, measles 1, tuberculosis 72, typhoid fever 12.
