❑ Review of data

- Quadrivalent HPV vaccine in pregnancy registry
- Long term follow up data – quadrivalent vaccine
- HPV infection risk for research HPV laboratory workers
- HPV infection risk for selected health care workers

❑ Planning for updating ACIP statement

Plans for updated ACIP statement

- **Develop ACIP statement to consolidate and update**
 - 2007 - Quadrivalent HPV vaccine ACIP statement - females
 - 2009 - Bivalent HPV vaccine Policy Note - females
 - 2011 - Quadrivalent HPV vaccine Policy Note - males

- **Updated statement to include**
 - Female and male recommendations in one document
 - Reconciliation of wording differences

Plans for updated ACIP statement

- **Updates on**
 - Burden of infection and cancers
 - Cervical cancer screening
 - HPV vaccine trial data
 - HPV vaccine safety data
- **Other data**
 - Research laboratory worker and health care workers

Future workgroup plans

- ❑ Data on alternative schedules
 - Dobson (JAMA 2013) - presented to ACIP June 2012
 - Other ongoing studies
- ❑ Review of new data from ongoing trials of current and second generation vaccines
