# MMR Vaccine Work Group

## Terms of Reference

Review available data and discuss potential changes to current recommendations

### Activities

- Review epidemiology of measles, mumps, rubella, and CRS
- Review existing statements pertaining to MMR vaccine
- Review new data on MMR vaccine
  - Safety and immunogenicity among persons with HIV
  - Third dose for mumps outbreak control
- Revise/update existing recommendations into a single document

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## Recent Activities

- Discussed issues related to rubella vaccination policy
  - Revaccination of women of childbearing age who are rubella IgG negative
  - Birth before 1957 exception for women of childbearing age
- Reviewed changes to the MMR vaccine “evidence of immunity” requirements for health-care personnel
- Reviewed vaccine safety of MMR-containing vaccines
- Discussed recommendations for use of immune globulin for measles postexposure prophylaxis

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## Future Activities

- Draft and review updated statement for prevention of measles, rubella, and mumps
- ACIP vote on updated statement and policy changes at October 2012 meeting
