Term of Reference

 Ensure hepatitis B protection for healthcare personnel (HCP), including trainees, who received hepatitis B (HepB) vaccination in the remote past without post-vaccination serologic testing*

^{*}Or who no longer have a record of post-vaccination serologic test result

What This Term of Reference Will <u>Not</u> Cover...

- Long-term protection by HepB vaccine (except as it relates to waning anti-HBs in HCP)
- Management of HCP who are known HBsAg-positive (i.e., those with chronic hepatitis B infection)

Scenario #1: HCP Trainee

 An 18 year old female is entering nursing school. She has documentation of the complete HepB vaccine series in infancy, as part of universal infant vaccination. No post-vaccination serologic testing was done.

Scenario #2: HCP Non-Trainee

 A 48 year old hospital laboratory technician has documentation of the complete HepB vaccine series, which was provided by his employer 18 years ago. He is unsure whether any post-vaccination serologic testing was performed. He is now working in a different healthcare system.

History of Term of Reference ACIP February 2011

- Considered draft ACIP recommendations for immunization of HCP*
- 3 options for ensuring hepatitis B protection of vaccinated HCP with no previous post-vaccination serologic testing
- ACIP requested Hepatitis WG deliberate prior to voting on options

Draft Options for Ensuring Hepatitis B Virus Protection for Healthcare Personnel

- 1. No action unless exposed
- 2. Pre-exposure anti-HBs
- 3. Challenge dose of HepB vaccine

anti-HBs = Antibody to hepatitis B surface antigen

 - Present cost-effectiveness analysis and proposed wording for ACIP policy
- October 2012
 - Review policy options; consider vote
