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#### **Overall Updates**

#### **Update to 2019 Event Code List Released**

- CDC posted release 3 of the 2019 full and generic v2 only event code lists to the <u>Message</u>
   <u>Mapping Guide (MMG) Related Documentation Section of the HL7 Case Notification Resource</u>
   Center.
- The list of new conditions to the full 2019 event code list is the following:
  - o Candida auris, clinical (50263)
  - o Candida auris, colonization/screening (event code 50264)
  - Carbapenemase-Producing Carbapenem-Resistant Enterobacteriaceae (CP-CRE) (event code 50244)
  - Carbon Monoxide Poisoning (32016)
  - Respiratory Syncytial Virus-Associated Deaths (11646)
  - Enterotoxigenic E.coli (ETEC) (11566).
- The list of new Generic v2 only conditions is the following:
  - o Candia auris, clinical (event code 50263)
  - o Candida auris, colonization/screening (event code 50264)
  - Carbapenemase-Producing Carbapenem-Resistant Enterobacteriaceae (CP-CRE) (event code 50244)
  - o Carbon Monoxide Poisoning (32016)
  - Respiratory Syncytial Virus-Associated Deaths (11646).

#### Missed the 2019 CSTE Annual Conference? Here's What You Need To Know

- Key takeaway messages from NNDSS/NMI-related sessions include the following:
  - By December 2019, CDC expects to be receiving data by using new HL7 message mapping guides for all nationally notifiable diseases processed by NNDSS, plus 26 additional conditions.

- CDC recognizes that jurisdiction implementation of the messages requires significant effort and will take longer than expected.
- CDC is improving efficiency of systems and enhancing tools to support jurisdictions and CDC programs.
  - CDC is moving processing of the National Electronic Telecommunications
     System for Surveillance messages, old HL7 messages, and NEDSS Base
     System Master Message into the Message Validation, Processing, and
     Provisioning System (MVPS), which will show all cases in the MVPS Dashboard:
    - MVPS Dashboard will provide counts and show which records are included in weekly/annual statistics to facilitate reconciliation.
    - Customizable features will help users better manage and resolve errors and warnings.
  - CDC is redesigning the production of weekly and annual statistics to make the process more transparent.
- CDC is seeking jurisdiction input into a vision for the future of case-based surveillance.

- The NMI APHL Technical Assistance team is launching a new type of technical assistance to help groups, or *cohorts*, of public health agencies build and implement NNDSS HL7 case notification messages.
- Cohorts of 4–6 public health agencies will focus on specific message mapping guides.
- APHL subject matter experts will guide participants through planning, gap analysis, data extraction, HL7 message creation, and validation. At completion, public health agencies will be ready to begin onboarding.

#### **Production HL7 Case Notification Messages**

#### Arboviral v1.3

- The MMG and artifacts are available on the <u>NNDSS HL7</u> <u>Case Notification Resource Center</u>.
- There are 19 jurisdictions in production for arboviral.
- Alabama, Alaska, Illinois, Indiana, Nevada, New York City, Washington, and Wyoming are engaged in onboarding.

#### Congenital Syphilis (CS) and STD

- The MMG and artifacts are available on the NNDSS HL7 Case Notification Resource Center.
- Pilot jurisdictions Connecticut, Michigan, and North Carolina are engaged in onboarding.
- CDC is working on a schedule for states waiting to onboard and will provide details in future status updates.
- The STD v1.0.1 MMG and associated artifacts were posted on the HL7 Resource Center on 7/22/19. The new version of the MMG includes an updated value set. The STD v1.0 MMG is still supported for onboarding purposes.

#### Generic v2

- The MMG and artifacts are available on the NNDSS HL7 Case Notification Resource Center.
- There are 27 jurisdictions in production for generic v2.
- Indiana, Puerto Rico, and Rhode Island are engaged in onboarding.

#### **Hepatitis**

#### Babesiosis (Stage III—Final MMG)

- CDC posted the MMG and artifacts on the NNDSS HL7 Case Notification Resource Center on 7/22/19.
- Please use this guide to begin implementing your case notification messages in preparation for onboarding.

#### **Bacterial Special Pathogens (Requirements Analysis)**

- CDC is developing an MMG for brucellosis, anthrax, leptospirosis, and Hansen's disease.
- The CDC MMG team and CDC program began holding weekly MMG development meetings on 7/10/19.

#### Carbon Monoxide Poisoning (CO) (Requirements Analysis)

- CDC posted a draft CO MMG for external review to the HL7 Case Notification Resource Center on 7/25/19. The external review period is 7/25/19 to 8/22/19.
- CDC is preparing for the CSTE webinar to gather jurisdiction feedback on the draft MMG. The webinar is scheduled for 8/8/19. Details will be provided soon.

#### Foodborne and Diarrheal Diseases (FDD) (Stage III—Final MMG)

- A data element priority list developed by the CDC program was posted on the <u>NNDSS HL7</u> Case Notification Resource Center on 7/22/19.
- CDC continues to assist pilot jurisdictions during the onboarding process.
- The final FDD guide and artifacts are available on the <u>NNDSS HL7 Case Notification Resource</u> Center.
- Please use this guide to begin implementing your case notification messages in preparation for onboarding.

### Healthcare Associated Infections, Multi-Drug Resistant Organisms (HAI MDRO) (Stage II—Pilot Test-ready)

Piloting is underway.

#### **Lead Poisoning (Requirements Analysis)**

CDC continues to make progress in developing this MMG.

#### Listeriosis (Stage I—Draft)

No new updates at this time.

#### Lyme and Tickborne Rickettsial Diseases (TBRD) (Stage II—Pilot Test-ready)


Piloting is underway.

#### Malaria (Stage III—Final MMG)

 CDC anticipates posting the MMG and artifacts on the <u>NNDSS HL7 Case Notification Resource</u> <u>Center</u> at the beginning of August.

#### Measles (Stage II—Pilot Test-ready)

- Piloting is underway.
- CDC is piloting this guide in conjunction with the rubella and CRS MMGs.



#### Respiratory and Invasive Bacterial Disease (RIBD) (Stage II—Pilot Test-ready)

 Based on feedback from the CDC program and pilot jurisdictions, CDC updated the MMG structure and content, which extended piloting until early August.

#### Rubella and Congenital Rubella Syndrome (CRS) (Stage II—Pilot Test-ready)

- Piloting is underway.
- CDC is piloting these guides in conjunction with the measles MMG.

#### Trichinellosis (Stage III—Final MMG)

- CDC posted the MMG and artifacts on the NNDSS HL7 Case Notification Resource Center on 7/22/19.
- Please use this guide to begin implementing your case notification messages in preparation for onboarding.

## Tuberculosis (TB) and Latent Tuberculosis Infection (LTBI) (Pilot Test-ready—Accelerated Development Pilot)


 CDC has finalized the MMG and artifacts and expects to post them soon on the <u>NNDSS HL7</u> <u>Case Notification Resource Center</u>.
